DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product is not cleared for use in paper or adhesives which may come into contact with food. NUOSEPT 44 Microbiocide should not be used in products where prolonged human dermal contact is expected or which may come in direct contact with food.

Products containing NUOSEPT 44 Microbiocide may not make claims of antimicrobial activity other than protection of the article itself against growth of bacteria and mold in the treated article. If growth of bacteria and fungi in the treated article would lead to unpleasant odors and discoloration of the treated article, then such a claim may be made.

NUOSEPT 44 Microbiocide is a biocidal agent used to inhibit the growth of bacteria and fungi. It is for indoor commercial and industrial use and is generally effective at concentrations of 0.1% to 0.5% (2 to 10 gallons of NUOSEPT 44 Microbiocide per 1,000 gallons of the product being treated. This will yield 1,000 to 5,000 ppm of active ingredient). The concentration of NUOSEPT 44 Microbiocide necessary for adequate preservation will depend on a variety of factors including the use of other raw materials which may provide nutrients for bacterial growth. To determine more precise application rates, all products should be subject to microbial challenge testing.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Triple rinse container (or equivalent) promptly after emptying. Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into applications equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container ¼ full with water. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll back and forth ensuring at least one complete revolution for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times. Offer for recycling if available or reconditioning if appropriate or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
