This is in response to your request to amend the registration of the above-named product to include a minor formulation change and update the labeling.



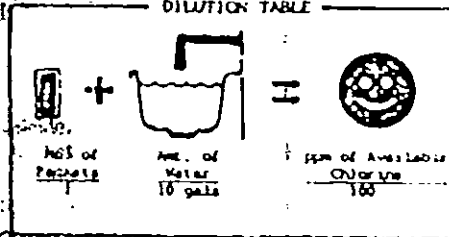
