

2. Five copies of the finished printed labels, as defined in the A-79 enclosure, must be submitted to the Agency before the product is released for shipment to comply with PR Notice 82-2 of June 18, 1982.
3. The finished printed labels must comply with the general labeling requirements of 40 Code of Federal Regulations §162.10. If the label does not satisfy these requirement, it will be rejected.
4. This registration is being issued with the understanding that the derivative of cyanuric acid which is contained in this product is under scrutiny for potential adverse effects to humans. There may be some regulatory actions directed against all registered products containing this chemical as an active ingredient at some time in the future.

2. Open McD Laundry Pak and squeeze contents into machine. Discard empty packet in trash.
3. Shake out loose soil from towels.
4. Place soiled towels in washer; no more than 40 towels for best results. Wash grill cloths separately.
5. Add contents of one packet of McD Powder Bleach. For larger or heavily soiled loads use an extra packet of Bleach. Discard packet(s) in trash.

IMPORTANT

Do not use this product in place of McD Sanitizer. McD Powder Bleach is for laundry only. McD Sanitizer is for equipment and utensil sanitizing.
