### FOR TOWELS AND GRILL CLOTHS

1. Set dial to normal cycle and hot water; then start machine.
2. Squeeze contents of one McD<sup>®</sup> Laundry Pak into machine.
3. Shake out loose soil.
4. Wash no more than 40 towels per load. Wash grill cloths separately.
5. Add contents of one packet of McD<sup>®</sup> Powder Bleach. For larger or heavily soiled loads, use an extra packet of Bleach. Discard packet(s) in trash.

Store in cool, dry area. DO NOT mix with ammonia, acids or other chemicals except McD<sup>®</sup> Laundry Pak.
