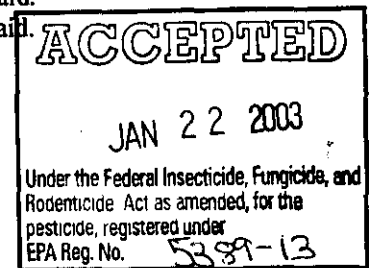

DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE BEFORE USING/CLOSE CAP AFTER USING/KEEP FROM FREEZING

CLEANING

1. Apply to surface directly, or with a damp cloth or sponge.
2. Rub surface thoroughly
3. Rinse with water.

NOTE: May scratch fiberglass, plastic and other soft surfaces. Test first and rub gently.

DISINFECTING TOILETS AND URINALS

1. Flush first to remove any loose soil and residual water.
2. Apply SPIRIT to bowl surface, under and around rim of bowl. Spread with toilet bowl brush to cover entire surface.
3. Let stand for 10 minutes and flush. (Use a wet cloth, sponge or spray to rinse surfaces that cannot be flushed.)

OTHER SURFACES

1. Rinse or wipe off loose soil.
2. Apply SPIRIT to surface directly or with damp cloth or sponge, covering surface thoroughly.
3. Let stand for 10 minutes and rinse.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS.

CAUTION: Can cause eye irritation. Do not get in eyes. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

Do not mix with other products. Use with adequate ventilation. Avoid contact with fabrics that are not bleach safe.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Keep container closed when not in use. Store in cool, dry area.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Rinse empty container thoroughly and discard in trash.

FIRST AID

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15 – 20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin with plenty of water for 15 – 20 minutes. Call a poison control center for treatment advice.

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
