Attachment A - Batch 3 Products

Labeling:

1. The signal word is "Danger".
2. The Precautionary Statements should read:

"Corrosive: Cause irreversible eye damage. May be fatal if inhaled. Causes skin irritation. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Do not breathe dust. Wear goggles or face shield. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse".

3. The Statements of Practical Treatment should read:

If Swallowed: Drink promptly large quantities of water. Do not induce vomiting. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician or Poison Control Center.

If on Skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.

If Inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably, mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.

If in Eyes: Hold eyelids open and flush with a steady, gentle stream of water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

Note to Physician: Probably mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.

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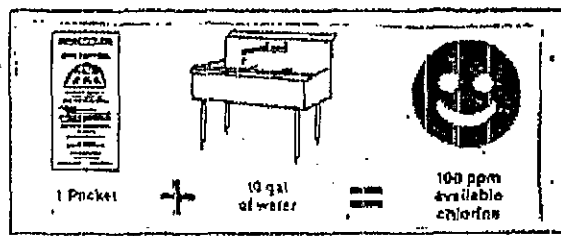

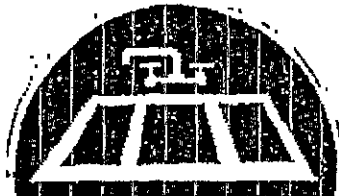
1. Scrape or rinse all loose food soils.
2. Brush wash with a suitable detergent.
3. Rinse thoroughly with clean, hot water.
4. In a clean sink approximately 1/2 full (10 gal) of lukewarm water (75°F), mix 1 packet of KAY-LP Sanitizer (yields 100 ppm available chlorine). Immerse utensils or equipment for 1-2 minutes. Remove and drain. Place on a clean surface to dry. Follow local health ordinances.

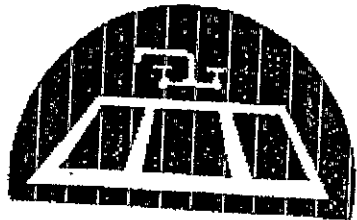
