Deficiencies of Zinc, Manganese and Iron may cause Chlorosis in some plants, including: Citrus, Gardenias, Camellias, Oleander, Hibiscus, Apples, Peaches. This results in yellow leaves and weak fruit and blossoms. The Trace Elements will correct for these nutritional deficiencies.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Shake well before using. Mix only the amount of spray to be immediately used. Follow dilution instructions carefully. Spray thoroughly especially the underside of foliage, stems and ground around the plants. By spraying thoroughly you will spray less often. Clean spray equipment after each use.

SPRING & SUMMER SPRAY: Use 1 1/2 Tablespoonfuls per gallon of water. One Pint makes 25 gallons of diluted spray. 2 Capful. 1 Tablespoonful. Spray as Insects appear or before Diseases are expected to appear and repeat at 7 to 10 day intervals until controlled.

This dilution will control APHIS, POWDERY MILDEW, RED SPIDER, ROSE RUST, MEALY BUG, SCALE CRAWLERS, LEAFHOPPER, CYCLAMEN MITE, WHITE FLY, TENT CATERPILLAR AND CERTAIN OTHERS, on:

ORNAMENTALS; Roses, Azaleas, Camellias, Ferns, Fuschias, Pyracantha, Ivy, Holly, Gardenias, Philodendron, Pines, Sycamore, Succulents.

FLOWERS; Begonias, Pansies, Geraniums, African Violets, Stock, Snapdragons, Cinerarias, Orchids.

VEGETABLES, VINES, NUTS; Squash, Beans, Melons, Cabbage, Cucumbers, Strawberries, Blackberries, Walnuts.

For Lawn Moth sprinkle one gallon of diluted spray per 20 square feet of lawn area.

DORMANT FRUIT TREE & CLEAN-UP SPRAY: Use 3 tablespoonfuls per gallon of water. One Pint makes 12 gallons of diluted spray.

For PEACH LEAF CURL on Peaches and Nectarines, spray in the late fall after pruning and again just as buds start to swell.

For SHOT HOLE FUNGUS, BROWN ROT or FRUIT BLIGHT on Apricots, Plums, Apples, Cherries, Pears, Almonds; spray in the late fall then when fruit buds break and again at petal fall.

For BROWN ROT or BLUE MOLD on Citrus, spray the lower part of tree trunk during winter months.

CLEAN-UP SPRAY all your garden in the late fall and again in the late winter to greatly reduce active Insects and Diseases during the growing season. For SOIL INSECTS such as MEALY BUG, water plants thoroughly with this dilution.

Dip BULBS for 1/2 hour just before planting for Aphis, Exposed Thrips, Red Spider.
