CLEANING AND DEODORIZING: Whenever practical CLEANING AND DEDDOHIZING: Whenever practical flush away gross soils with water. For cleaning and deodor izing use 5 to 8 ounces of PHENOMINT 7 per gailton of water. Cleaning may be accomplished with a Lean mop shonge, squeegee, wet vacuum system or a mechanical soreying device.
