PHENOMINT 7 is effective against a wide variety of gram positive and gram negative bacteria.

PHENOMINT 7 may be used for the general disinfection of hard, non porous inanimate surfaces (glass, metal, plastic, glazed porcelain, linoleum, tile, leather, vinyl, enamel and finished wood surfaces) on walls, floors, appliances and furnishings in industrial and commercial offices, restrooms and work areas.

PHENOMINT 7 is also an excellent deodorant. It is especially effective in controlling odors that are bacterial in origin.

PHENOMINT 7 mixes readily with water and makes a clear stable solution. In use dilution it is non corrosive and non staining to plastic, vinyl, synthetics, enamel, tile and most common metals. PHENOMINT 7 has a pleasant mint odor.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS DANGER

Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food. Avoid breathing spray mist.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS: Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to fish. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds, or public water unless in accordance with an NPDES Permit.

Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or by disposing of wastes.

USE DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

CLEANING AND DEODORIZING: Whenever practical flush away gross soils with water. For cleaning and deodorizing use 5 to 8 ounces of PHENOMINT 7 per gallon of water. Cleaning may be accomplished with a clean mop, sponge, squeegee, wet vacuum system or a mechanical spraying device. After cleaning remove suspended soils with a clear water rinse, vacuum pick up or by wiping with a clean mop, sponge, squeegee or cloth.

DISINFECTING: Before disinfecting, pre-clean surfaces as directed above. Then prepare 5 ounces of PHENOMINT 7 per gallon of water and thoroughly wet the surfaces to be disinfected. The disinfecting solution must contact the surface for 10 minutes for proper disinfection. If desired the surfaces may then be rinsed with clear water or wiped with a clean damp cloth.

FOR CLEANING AND DEODORIZING of Garbage cans, Garbage trucks, Industrial Waste Receptacles and other Garbage handling equipment: It is especially important to pre-clean, in order for the disinfectant to perform properly. Then apply a wetting solution of 8 ounces of PHENOMINT 7 per gallon of water.

FOR CLEANING of Walls, Floors, and Industrial Work Areas use 5 to 8 ounces per gallon of water. The use of rubber gloves is recommended for persons doing continuous hand cleaning.

This product must not be used on food contact surfaces.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
