

This spray possesses rapid knock-down properties, when one gallon of the concentrate is diluted with 6/8 gallons of Deodorized Spray Base and applied as a mist filling areas at least ten minutes. Care should be taken not to apply the spray directly to food products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

When used as directed, this material will control the exposed stages of Flies, Mosquitos and Gnats. Spray directly on Roaches, Grain Mites, Sowbugs, Spiders and Centipedes. Use this product as a space-spray in processing plants only when plant is not in operation. Fill the area with mist for at least ten minutes. Food should be removed or covered during treatment and all processing surfaces thoroughly cleaned before using. Caution: "Do not remain in treated area, and ventilate the area after treatment is completed."

Mix with Deodorized Spray Base at the rate of one gallon of concentrate to 6/8 gallons of Deodorized Spray Base. Agitation is desirable before using. Apply liberally and when possible, directly on the listed insects. However, this spray should not be applied to ceilings or walls near vessels that are to be used for processing foods, since listed insects that are partially paralyzed may drop into the product being processed. In food processing plants particularly flour and cereal plants the infested stock should be removed from machines, conveyors, etc., and those areas liberally sprayed.
