- 1. Replace the statement, "For Professional Use Only" with a statement such as, "For institutional/ commercial use only." (The term "Professional" is undefined in this type of statement.)
- In the last sentence before the DIRECTIONS FOR USE heading, replace the phrase "Influenza virus and Type A Brazil" with, "Influenza virus Type A/Brazil".
