B-Q 32 is a cleaner, disinfectant, deodorizer, fungicide and virucide* developed for use where housekeeping and reduction of the hazard of cross-infection by environmental surfaces are of prime importance. This disinfectant is effective against a wide variety of gram-positive and gram-negative bacteria. It is also an excellent deodorant and is especially effective in controlling odors that are bacterial in origin.

This disinfectant is effective at 6 oz./gal. (47 ml/litre) against *Pseudomonas aeruginosa* PRD-10, *Salmonella choleraesuis* ATCC 10708, and *Staphylococcus aureus* ATCC 6538 when tested by the A.O.A.C. Use Dilution Test Method for pre-cleaned, hard non-porous surfaces.

*This disinfectant is also an effective virucide at 6 oz./gal. (47 ml/litre) for Influenza virus, Type A Brazil on inanimate environmental surfaces.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. 1. **Dilutions:** *For Cleaning:* To clean and deodorize or to pre-clean prior to disinfection, use 3 to 12 oz. of B-Q 32 per gallon (23-94 ml/litre) of water depending on soil level. *For Disinfection:* Use 7 1/2 oz. of B-Q 32 per gallon (59 ml/litre) of water for one step cleaning and disinfecting on light to medium soil loads. *For Heavily Soiled Areas:* Pre-clean first and then disinfect with this product at 6 oz. per gallon (47 ml/litre). *For Deodorizing:* Pre-clean first and then use 16 oz. of B-Q 32 per gallon (125 ml/litre) of water. *For Mildew Control:* Follow directions for disinfecting and repeat every 7 days. 2. **Applications:** Apply the use-solution with a clean mop, sponge, cloth, squeegee or mechanical scrubber.

Prepare fresh use-solutions daily. Do not reuse solutions. Discard solutions when they become visibly soiled. For disinfection, thoroughly wet the surfaces to be treated. Surfaces must remain moist for at least 10 minutes to assure proper germicidal action.

This product may be used for cleaning and disinfecting hard non-porous, inanimate environmental surfaces (glass, metal, glazed porcelain, linoleum, tile, smooth leather, vinyl, enameled and finished wood surfaces) on walls, floors, appliances and furnishings.

El B-Q 32 es un limpiador, desinfectante, desodorante, fungicida y virucida para uso en donde la limpieza, el orden y la reducción de los peligros de infecciones cruzadas por las superficies ambientales tengan una importancia primordial.

INDICACIONES DE USO: El uso de este producto de modos que no vayan de acuerdo con lo indicado en la etiqueta constituye una violación de las leyes federales. 1. **Diluciones:** Para limpieza: Para limpiar y desodorizar o para limpieza previa a la desinfección, use de 3 a 12 onzas por galón de agua, dependiendo de la cantidad de suciedad. Para desinfección: Use 7 1/2 onzas por galón de agua para limpieza y desinfección de una sola pasada en cargas de suciedad ligeras a medianas. Para zonas muy sucias: Haga primeramente una limpieza previa. Luego, desinfecte con este producto a razón de 6 onzas por galón. Para desodorizar: Limpie primeramente. A continuación utilice 16 onzas por galón de agua. Para controlar el moho: Siga las indicaciones de desinfección y repita la operación cada 7 días. 2. **Aplicaciones:** Aplique la solución de uso con un trapo, una esponja, un compresor de jergas o un trapeador mecánico. Prepare diariamente soluciones de uso nuevas. No vuelva a utilizar las soluciones. Descártelas cuando estén visiblemente sucias. Para la desinfección, humedezca bien las superficies que se deben tratar. Deberán permanecer húmedas al menos durante 10 minutos, para asegurar una acción germicida apropiada. Este producto se puede utilizar para limpiar y desinfectar superficies ambientales inanimadas duras y no porosas (vidrio, metal, porcelana vidriada, linóleo, azulejos, cuero pulido, vinilo, superficies de madera acabadas y esmaltadas) en paredes, suelos, aparatos y muebles.

PELIGROSO PARA SERES HUMANOS Y ANIMALES DOMÉSTICOS
