Statement of Practical Treatment

Directions for Use

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

This is a product of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Sanitizing of Food Processing Equipment and Other Hard Surfaces in Food Contact Locations. For sanitizing food processing equipment, dairy equipment, food utensils, and other hard surfaces, sink tops, countertops, and other hard surfaces for spray equipment and other hard surfaces. No potable water is required.

Wash and rinse articles thoroughly. Then apply a solution of 1/2 oz. M-C Sanitizer in 4 gallons of water. If 50 ppm solution is desired, it remains wet for at least one minute. Wash thoroughly. Do not drink any of the solution. Do not use for sanitizing dairy equipment. Do not use for sanitizing dairy equipment.

Apply to all hard surfaces, refrigerated storage and other stationary hard surfaces by using a mechanical spray device. No potable water is required.

Use for sanitizing glasses, cooking utensils and other articles for a process of reduction of bacteria. Use 1/2 oz. M-C Sanitizer in 4 gallons of water. No potable water is required.

Apply 1/2 oz. M-C Sanitizer to 4 gallons of water. This is the criteria of a sanitizing solution. A Pasteurized Milk Ordinance (PMO) sanitizing solution of the U.S. Public Health Service is 1/2 oz. of a 1% solution of sodium hypochlorite (bleach) which is equivalent to 1/2 oz. of M-C Sanitizer in 4 gallons of water. No potable water is required.

Cleaning and Sanitizing

1. All hard surfaces shall be thoroughly pre-washed or cleaned with a detergent solution before sanitizing.
