- d. Under the "First Aid" statement change the word "Advise" to read "Advice".
- e. Under the "Directions for Use" delete the organisms "Escherichia coli" and "Staphylococcus aureus" or submit data to support the efficacy claims.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For sanitization of dishes and utensils. Remove hot water from the fire and dissolve one tablet in 8 to 10 quarts of rinse water. Immerse dishes and utensils in the sanitizing solution for one minute. Remove and allow to air dry. Used as directed, rinse will effectively act as a sanitizer against ~~Escherichia coli~~ and ~~Staphylococcus aureus~~.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep product dry in tightly closed container when not in use. Store in cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat or open flame. Do not reuse empty container. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water to dissolve all material before discarding. Securely wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

DANGER. Corrosive to eyes. Causes eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Protect eyes and skin when handling. Harmful if swallowed. Do not breathe dust. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after handling.
