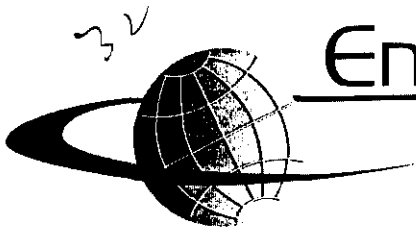

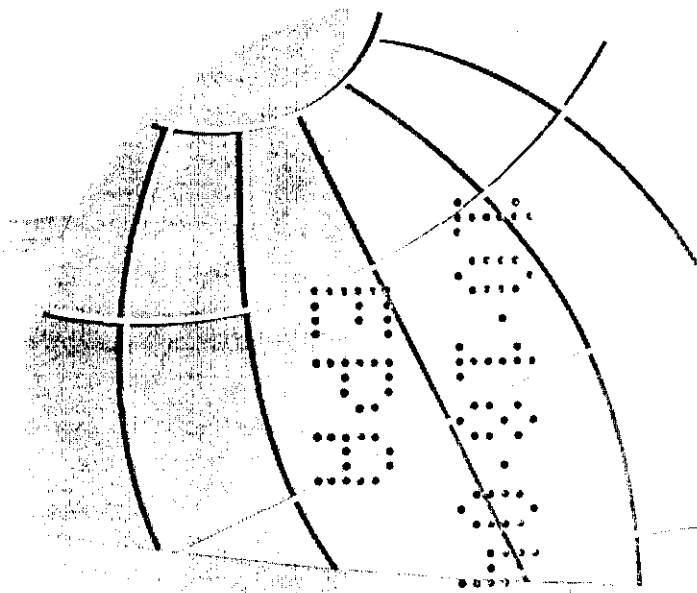

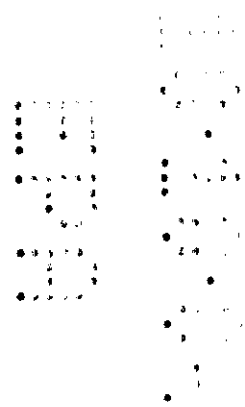

SUPPLEMENTAL PRODUCT INFORMATION

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For sanitization of dishes and utensils. Dissolve sanitizing solution in 8 to 10 quarts of rinse water. Immerse dishes and utensils in the sanitizing solution for one minute. Remove and allow to air dry. Used as directed, rinse will effectively act as a sanitizer.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep product dry in tightly closed container when not in use. Store in cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat or open flame. Do not reuse empty container. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water to dissolve all material before discarding. Securely wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER. Corrosive to eyes. Causes eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Protect eyes and skin when handling. Harmful if swallowed. Do not breathe dust. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after handling.

FIRST AID

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.
