

ALCO FLY FIGHTER INSECT SPRAY — Pressurized

This product may be injurious to health, read entire label. Use only as directed. Hold container upright to spray. Point valve opening a way from face when spraying. Point spray away from people, plants and pets. Spray only on surface. Do not use as a space spray.

DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

TO OPERATE: Align valve opening with back line on top rim of can. Hold can upright and spray infested areas only until surfaces are slightly wet.

FLIES, GNATS, MOSQUITOES, MOTHS, WASPS: Spray outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames, or wherever pests might gain entrance into building. Treat surfaces around light fixtures or where insects land or congregate. Treat interior or garbage cans including underside of lid. Repeat as needed.

ROACHES, ANTS, WATERBUGS, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS, AND CRICKETS: Spray into all cracks and crevices around baseboards and other places where these insects hide. Also spray until slightly wet, surfaces behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, etc. Spray other localized infested areas. Repeat as required. DO NOT remain in room unless it is thoroughly ventilated.

DOG TICKS: Thoroughly spray infested areas around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, sleeping quarters of household pets and localized areas of floor and floor coverings. Applications should be repeated as infestations warrant. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters after treatment. Do not apply to animals.

FLEAS, CHIGGERS, ANTS, DOG TICKS: Outdoor, for treatment of localized infestations spray infested areas thoroughly.

DISPOSAL

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid skin contacts, wash thoroughly after using. Avoid breathing of spray mist. **KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.** Do not apply to surfaces contacted frequently by children or allow them in areas where surfaces are not yet dry. Wash after handling.

Avoid contamination of food and foodstuffs. Do not treat areas where food or food crops are growing.

DO NOT use on pets or animals.

DO NOT use in edible product areas of food processing plants, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in eating areas while food is exposed.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed—Call a physician immediately. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. DO NOT INDUCE vomiting unless other treatment is not available. If on skin—Wash immediately with soap and water.

If in eyes—Flush eyes for at least 15 minutes with water. Call a physician immediately.
