The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below:

1. Revise the Statement of Practical Treatment to read as follows:

IF SWALLOWED: Call a doctor or get medical attention. Do not induce vomiting. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Avoid alcohol.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

2. Revise the Statement of Practical Treatment to read as follows:

"Harmful if swallowed. Avoid inhalation of vapors. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling."

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records. Submit three copies of final printed labeling prior to releasing product for shipment.

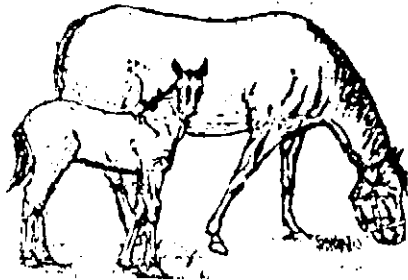
