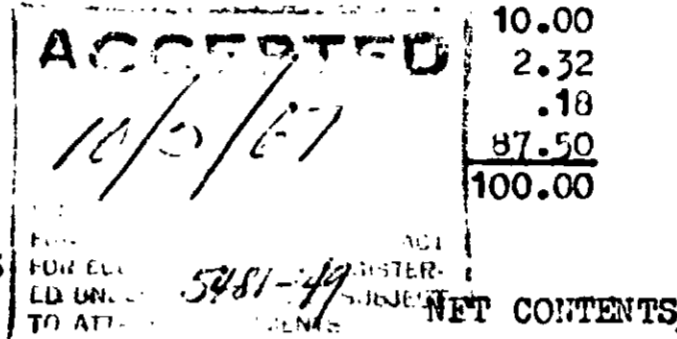

Vapodrin Concentrate is a combination of Clodrin and DDVP to be mixed with either spray base oil or diesel oil. Vapodrin Concentrate can be applied with either hand, power or automatic spray equipment or be used in back rubbers. The dilute spray can be used on lactating dairy animals. No feed off period is necessary when the dilute spray is used on beef animals.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE AND APPLICATION:

Mix Vapodrin Concentrate at the rate of one gallon of concentrate to nine gallons of either spray base oil or diesel oil. Do not mix with water.

ON LACTATING DAIRY COWS AND BEEF ANIMALS:

Apply the dilute spray as a fine mist to thoroughly cover all parts of the animal, including the legs. Apply daily. Make application so as to moisten the hair only and not to exceed 2 fluid ounces per animal per day. Best results will be obtained by making application in the morning. This application will control house flies, stable flies, and horn flies. Do not wet the skin due to possible skin irritation. Do not apply regularly to calves under six months of age. Do not apply to Brahman cattle as they show hypersensitivity to organic phosphates.

BACK RUBBER USE:

Dilute Vapodrin Concentrate one gallon to nine gallons of either diesel oil or spray base oil. Fill reservoir on automatic back rubbers. Refill as necessary. On Burlap back rubbers apply one gallon of the dilute solution to each twenty lineal feet.

WARNING: Avoid prolonged or repeated inhalation of mist and contact with skin. In case of contact with skin or eyes, flush with plenty of water, for eyes get medical attention. Keep away from open flames. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking. Do not contaminate feed, water or foodstuffs. If swallowed, induce vomiting immediately and get medical attention. Atropine is antidotal. This product is toxic to fish.

DECONTAMINATE AND DESTROY USED CONTAINERS: Do not re-use for any purpose. Decontaminate containers by rinsing thoroughly with water and detergent. Destroy containers by crushing and burying in an isolated area. Dispose of rinsings in a way as not to constitute a hazard, or contaminate water supplies.
