The proposed amendment to the registration of the product cited above under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, rearranging the label format and adding a Statement of Practical Treatment, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy of the draft label is enclosed for your records. Five copies of the finished printed label must be submitted before the product is released for shipment under this amended label.

1. Change the statement "Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes" to read "Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters."
2. The Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) on record for this product does not meet current requirements. Submit the required EPA Form 8570-4 (Rev. 2-85). A blank copy is enclosed for your use. All applicable items must be completed correctly. Note that you are required to include in the form certified limits for each component introduced into your product (formulation). Also you must specify in the CSF certified limits for each active ingredient so declared on the proposed label for your product. The certified limits for the active ingredients must be expressed as pure active ingredients. Note also that the certified lower limits for the active ingredients expressed therein cannot be lower than your label declarations for the active ingredients. In other words, the current regulations as

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Hold container in upright position 12-16 inches away from animal, pointing valve opening toward animal. Release spray by pressing valve down.

Spray in a zig-zag motion so as to lightly and evenly dampen animal's coat. Spray all areas especially legs and under belly for best results.

For Face Flies, spray to slightly dampen animal's face. Do not apply more than one ounce per animal. Repeat as required. Horses can be worked or ridden immediately after use. Avoid spraying directly in animal's eyes.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Do not breathe spray mist. Do not get in eyes or on skin. Do not contaminate feed or foodstuffs. Do not use on beef or dairy cattle.
