The proposed amendment to the registration of the product cited above under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, removing the active ingredient, MGK R-11, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

1. Submit the product-specific product chemistry and the data matrix for the new formulation.
2. Provide the flashpoint of the product with the propellant or change the physical and chemical hazards to read:

Extremely Flammable. Contents under pressure. Keep away from fire, sparks, and heated surfaces. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130 °F may cause bursting.

3. In the Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) dated June 28, 1990, the oil of citronella is listed as a perfume and considered an inert ingredient. On the label, however, it is listed as an active ingredient. This ingredient must be deleted from the actives and its percentage included with the inert ingredients in the ingredient statement.

4. Based on the CSF dated June 28, 1990, the product will not meet the label claim for the active ingredient, NGK Repellent 326. On the CSF column 13.a., the amount is listed as 0.4 lb and on the label you claim 0.4 percent. However in columns 13.b. and 14.b. of the CSF you claim 0.2 percent and 0.25 percent, respectively. Note that the lower certified limit of the active ingredients must be the same as the label claim in pure active form. Make the necessary changes in the CSF to meet the label claim. Submit a revised CSF.
5. Change the statement "Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposing of wastes" to read "Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters."
6. Submit a 1-year storage stability study. The formulated product must be analyzed for its active ingredients at ~~the~~ ^{the} ~~time~~ ^{time} ~~and~~ ^{and} during a year of storage. The storage must be under warehouse conditions of temperature and humidity using containers similar to those that will be used in the trade. This data must be submitted with 15 months of the date of this letter.
