USE AS AN AREA SPRAY: For outdoor use, misting an area when the air is still will reduce the numbers of annoying insects during picnic meals. Grill area and tables may be sprayed but avoid spraying directly on foods or utensils.

BACK PANEL

READ ENTIRE LABEL BEFORE USING. USE ONLY AS DIRECTED.

SHAKE BEFORE USE. HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT. APPLY IN SHORT BURSTS.

INDOORS: To kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Wasps, Flying Moths and Other Flying Insects. Cover exposed food and utensils. Cover fish bowls and remove bird cages. Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5 - 10 seconds for average room. Keep nozzle 3 feet from surfaces. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying.

To kill Roaches, Waterbugs, Silverfish, Crickets, Ants and other Crawling Insects: Spray baseboards, cracks, crevices, moist areas, and openings around sinks and pipes and other hiding places, hitting the insects directly. Spray ant hills and ant trails over window and door sills and other locations.

For house plants, spray in short bursts, holding the can 18 inches from foliage for such plants as English Ivy and African Violets. Spray both sides of the leaves lightly. Do not wet. Repeat as often as necessary. Kills Aphids, (plant lice), Spider Mites, exposed Thrips, Lace bugs and Certain Other Insects.

OUTDOORS: For bugs on such plants as Asters, Anemones, Begonias, Chrysanthemums, Dahlias, Delphiniums, Gladioli, Irises, Marigolds, Petunias, Roses, and Snapdragons. Also, for bugs on Evergreens and Small Ornamental Deciduous Trees, Shrubs and Vines.

When sprayed directly on insects this spray kills sucking insects such as Aphids, Leafhoppers, Spotted Mites, Thrips (exposed) and Lace Bugs. Kills chewing insects such as Caterpillars, Climbing cutworms, Flea Beetles, Rose Chry, when sprayed directly.

For best results, spray in evening or on a cloudy day when air is still. Use slow, sweeping motion. Keep can 24 inches from plants. Avoid wetting foliage with the spray. Spray rows at the rate of 1 foot per second. For heavy growth, spray row on both sides. Repeat when needed. Spray with caution on young plants and new growth. Do not spray when temperature exceeds 90° F.
