GENERAL DIRECTIONS:

NEVADA SCRATCH ANIMAL SPRAY SOLUTION is a specially formulated ready to use insecticide suitable for use in conventional hand, power or automatic spray equipment, and in back subbers. This product is approved for use on lactating dairy animals. No feed-off period is necessary when used on beef animals. Apply with hand, power or automatic equipment to moisten the hair only and not in excess of 2 fluid ounces daily per animal. Do not wet the skin due to possible skin irritation. Do not apply regularly to calves under 6 months of age. Brahman cattle should not be treated as they may show hypersensitivity to organic phosphates.

For the control of certain insects attacking animals, apply in accordance with State and Federal Recommendations.

USE AND DIRECTIONS FOR APPLICATION:

Lectating Dairy and Beef Animals: For control of Horn Flies, Face Flies, Stable Flies and House Flies.

Make a light application daily as a fine-mist to thoroughly cover all parts of the animal, including legs. Morning application is preferred.

Lactating Dairy and Beef Animals: Lice

Make 1-2 applications of 3-3% ounces at 14 day intervals as a fine mist spray to thoroughly cover all parts of the animals. If material is applied by fogging or misting equipment, the maximum spraying time per animal is 20 accords.

Back and Fact Rubbers: Horn flies, Face flies.

For use on lactating dairy and beef animals, use one (1) gallon for each 20 linear feet of burlap back rubber. For automatic back rubbers, recharge reservoir as needed. Animals must rub face on rubbers for best face fly control.

CAUTION: Avoid prolonged or repeated inhalation of mist and contact with skin. Harmful if swallowed. In case of contact with skin or eyes, flush with plenty of water, for eyes, get medical attention. Keep away from open flame. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking. Do not contaminate feed, water or foodstuffs. If swallowed, induce vomiting immediately and get medical attention. Atropine is antidotal. Do not reuse container. Destroy when empty.
