NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

POISONING SYMPTOMS: Symptoms include weakness, headache, tightness in chest, blurred vision, non-reactive pin point pupils, salivation, sweating, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, and abdominal cramps. TREATMENT: Atropine is the specific therapeutic antagonist of choice against parasympathetic nervous stimulation. If there are signs of parasympathetic stimulation, Atropine Sulfate should be injected at 10-minute intervals in doses of 1 to 2 milligrams until complete atropinization has occurred. Morphine is contraindicated. 2 PAM is also antidotal and may be administered but only in conjunction with Atropine. Clear chest by postural drainage. Repeated exposure to cholinesterase inhibitors may, without warning, cause prolonged susceptibility to very small doses of any cholinesterase inhibitor. Allow no further exposure until time for cholinesterase regeneration has been allowed as determined by blood test.

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER. Poisonous if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin or eyes. Rapidly absorbed through skin. Repeated inhalation or skin contact may, without symptoms, progressively increase susceptibility to DDVP poisoning. Do not swallow or get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Do not breathe vapors. Keep out of reach of children and domestic animals. Do not contaminate water, feed or foodstuffs. Mix the concentrate outdoors or in a well ventilated room. Keep all unprotected persons out of operational area. In case of contact, wash immediately with soap and water. Wash thoroughly with soap and water before eating or smoking. Wash all contaminated clothing with soap and hot water before reuse.

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)

Do not treat more than five applications sites per day and do not make DDVP applications more than once per week.

ALCO FLY FIGHTER Liquid Concentrate is an insecticide especially formulated for the control of resistant and non-resistant flies around dairy farms, stables, barns, feed yards, corrals, loafing sheds, battery poultry establishments, farm buildings, animal hospitals, refuse collection areas and garbage cans. Applied inside garbage cans, if keeps yellow jackets under control in local areas. Refer to PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE) paragraph for information concerning an approved respirator to be used when applying this product.

FLY CONTROL ON DAIRY AND BEEF CATTLE

Mix 1 gallon ALCO FLY FIGHTER Liquid Concentrate in 50 gallons of water (5 tbsp. Or 2-1/2 fl. oz. per gallon of water). Apply 2 to 4 fl. oz. daily per animal as a mist spray, using a hand or automatic sprayer. Do not apply more than 4 fl. oz. per animal. Apply as to wet the hair. Do not apply to young calves under 6 months old. After treating dairy animals, wash the teats with an approved cleaning solution and then dry them prior to milking. Do not treat sick or convalescing animals. Do not treat Brahman or Brahman-Cross cattle, as they may show hypersensitivity to organophosphate insecticides. Do not apply dermally in conjunction with trichlorfon and do not use on animals simultaneously or within a few days before or after treatment with, or exposure to cholinesterase inhibiting drugs, pesticides or chemicals. Do not make direct application to livestock more frequently than once per day.

GARBAGE CANS, REFUSE CANS

To give local control of yellow jackets, apply the 0.5% spray to the inside of the lid and inside of the container each time the container is emptied.

ANIMAL BUILDINGS

Dairy barns, stables, livestock buildings, loafing sheds, pig pens: Before treatment, close all doors, windows, and other openings. Remove animals before treatment. Applicator must not remain in treated area. Start application at far end of building and hack up towards exit while treating. Keep area closed for at least 10 minutes to kill resting, adult flying insects. After treatment the area should be opened up and ventilated prior to reoccupying by humans or animals. Do not contaminate feed, food, water, foodstuffs, milk or milking utensils. Do not apply in areas where animals have received direct application of DDVP within 8 hours. Spraying of animals should be done outdoors as a separate treatment. Repeat treatments as necessary.

Fogging: Apply as a 0.5% to 1.0% fog to control flies, gnats and mosquitoes. For the 0.5% solution, mix 1 pint in 7 gallons of diesel oil. For the 1.0% solution, mix 1 quart in 7 gallons of diesel oil. Employ an appropriate "fogging" machine to apply at the rate of 1 quart of the 0.5% solution or 1 pint of the 1.0% solutions for 8,000 cubic feet.

Spraying: For control of flies, gnats, mosquitoes, roaches, fleas, ants, sowbugs and brown dog ticks, apply as a 0.5% solution by mixing 2-1/2 fl. oz. in 1 gallon of water, equal to 1 pint in 6 gallons of water or 1 gallon in 50 gallons of water. (A baited spray can be prepared by adding 1 pound of sugar per 1 gallon of spray solution). Apply as a coarse, wet spray at the rate of 1 quart per 1,000 sq. ft. Treat doorways, feed storage rooms, alleyways, and window sills. Repeat treatment as needed for insect control.

Treatment should be made during hours when buildings are unoccupied. Buildings should be closed and ventilation kept at a minimum during application of the insecticide. Lock all entrances and do not allow unprotected workers to enter building when being treated.

POULTRY HOUSES

Apply to manure, window sills, outside of penned enclosures, and on floor of feed storage rooms.

DOG KENNELS

Apply to outside of dog runways, window sills and ledges. For the control of fleas and brown dog ticks, increase dosage to 2 quarts of 0.5% spray per 1,000 sq. ft. For indoor uses only crack and crevice treatments are permitted. Space spray use is prohibited.

MANURE PILES, GARBAGE DUMPS

For the control of fly maggots in maggot breeding areas, apply at the rate of 1 to 2 quarts of 0.5% spray per 100 sq. ft. Birds feeding on treated areas may be killed.
