Change "Keep out of lakes, streams, or ponds" to "Do not discharge effluent containing this product directly into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or public waters unless this product is specifically identified and addressed in an NPDES permit. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sever systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance, contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the Environmental Protection Agency."
- b. Change "Wear a mask or respirator, etc." to "Wear a pesticide respirator jointly approved by the Mine Safety and Health Administration and by the Metional Institute for Occupational Safety and Health under the provisions of 30 CFR Part 11."

Please send us a copy of your Technical Bulletin for review.

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

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If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with TIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
