The labeling cited above and submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is accepted subject to the comments reflected on the enclosed sheet. A copy of your proposed labeling stamped "ACCEPTED WITH COMMENTS" is enclosed.

WHAT THIS ACCEPTANCE MEANS:

Based on your certification, the Agency has accepted the labeling changes that are necessary to comply with the Worker Protection Standard (WPS) labeling requirements of 40 CFR part 156, subpart K, described in PR Notices 93-7 and 93-11. Any other labeling changes submitted in connection with this amendment application but not directly related to compliance with the WPS have not been reviewed or accepted by the Agency. If you wish to make such changes, you must submit a separate amendment application proposing them. If your product is currently suspended, the acceptance of this labeling amendment does not affect the suspension in any way.

By the next label printing make all the specified changes to your labeling. Send to EPA one (1) copy of the final printed labeling:

You may delete the respirator statement added to your proposed label. It is not required for your product.

Remove the statement "Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application." from its current position within the Agricultural Use Box and place it above the Agricultural Use Box.

You have inecorrect wording in the second-to-last sentence in the first paragraph in the Agricultural Use Requirements box on your proposed label. The sentence must be as follows: "It also contains specific instructions and exceptions pertaining to the statements on this label about personal protective equipment (PPE), and restricted-entry interval."

The bodywear requirement for early entry in the Agricultural Use Requirement box on your proposed labeling is missing or incorrect. Remove the incorrect requirement (if any) and add "Coveralls". The exact location is shown in Sections F and G on Part 2 of the Product Worksheet in Supplement Three-A to PR Notice 93-7.

You must retain from your original label any statements about entry restrictions that apply to the non-agricultural uses on your product. VEGETABLE CROPS AND GARDENS

Artichoke, Asparagus, Beans, Beets, Blackeyed Peas, Broccoli, Brussels Sprouts, Cabbage, Cantaloupe, Cucumbers, Eggplant, Endive, Garlic, Ginseng, Horseradish, Kale, Kohlrabi, Leeks, Lettuce, Melons, Mustard Greens, Okra, Onions, Parsnips, Peas, Peppers, Pimentos, Potatoes, Pumpkins, Radishes, Rhubarb, Rutabagas, Salsify, Shallots, Spinach, Squash, Sweet Potatoss, Swiss Chard, Tornatoes, Turnips, Watermelons, Apply up to 20 lbs per acre.

ORNAMENTAL PLANTS

ORNAMENTAL GARDENS, PLANTED BORDERS AND GROUND COVERS: Including Azaleas, Begonias, Camelias, Chrysanthemums, Daffodils, Daisies, Geraniums, Honeysuckle, Hydrangeas, Ice Plant, Impatiens, Iris, Marigolds, Pansies, Petunias, Rhododendron, Rose, Sweet Peas, Snapdragons, Spathiphyllum, Tulips. Water the infested area thoroughly before application. Broadcast or sprinkle Durham Metaldehyde Granules 7.5 evenly over the infested areas and along edges of flower beds adjacent to border or ground cover plants. Also apply on ground at base of fences and walls in shady, protected locations. One pound will cover up to 2,500 Sq. Ft. Do not re-water for 48 hours

DICHONDRA AND/OR TURFGRASS LAWNS

Water infested area thoroughly before application. Broadcast Durham Metaldehyde Granules 7.5 directly on lewn or turf. Spread evenly. One pound will cover up to 1.500 sq. ft, Do not re-water for 48 hours.

ORNAMENTAL GREENHOUSES

Water or irrigate greenhouse soil to be treated before application. Broadcast Durham Metaldehyde Granules liberally around greenhouse, under benches in greenhouses and around plants; any place where SNAILS and SLUGS might congregate. Do not apply directly to plants unless prior experience has shown the plant to be tolerant to this product. Most plants are tolerant to Durham Metaldehyde Granules 7.5 however some slight tip burning has been notice on extremely tender orchids. One pound will cover up to 2,500 sq.ft. Do not re-water for 48 hours. NOTE: Durham Metaldehyde Granules 7.5 has proven to have a reasonable residual control, however for heavily infested greenhouses a second application is recommended 7 to 10 days following the first application to bring the house under control.

SEED GRASSES

Alfaifa, Barley, Hay, Oats, Wheat. Apply up to 40 tbs, per acre.
