# DUPHAM METALDEHYDE GRANULES

A SOIL SURFACE TREATMENT FOR CONTROL OF SNAILS & SLUGS IN ORCHARDS - SMALL FRUITS AND BERRIES - VEGETABLE GARDEN CROPS - FIELD CROPS - DICHONDRA and TURFGRASS LAWNS - FOR

Cereal Grains (Barley, Oats, Wheat), Corn, Legumes (Alfalfa, Beans, Clover, Cowpeas, Peas), Mint: Apply up to 40 pounds per acre.

**DICHONDRA AND/OR TURFGRASS LAWNS**

Water infested area thoroughly before application. Broadcast Durham Metaldehyde Granules 7.5 directly on lawn or turf. Spread evenly. One pound will cover up to 2,500 sq. ft. Do not re-water for 48 hours.

**ORNAMENTAL PLANTS**

## ORNAMENTAL GREENHOUSES

Water or irrigate greenhouse soil to be treated before application. Broadcast Durham Metaldehyde Granules liberally around greenhouse, under benches in greenhouses and around plants; any place where SNAILS and SLUGS might congregate. Do not apply directly to plants unless prior experience has shown the plant to be tolerant to this product. Most plants are tolerant to Durham Metaldehyde Granules 7.5 however some slight tip burning has been noticed on extremely tender orchids. One pound will cover up to 2,500 sq.ft. Do not re-water for 48 hours. NOTE: Durham Metaldehyde Granules 7.5 has proven to have a reasonable residual control, however for heavily infested greenhouses a second application is recommended 7 to 10 days following the first application to bring the house under control.

## SEED CROPS

Flowers, Grasses, Legumes (Alfalfa, Beans, Clover, Peas), Sugar Beets, and Vegetables (Beets, Cabbage, Carrots, Collards, Kale, Kohlrabi, Lettuce, Mustard, Radish, Spinach, Swiss Chard, Tobacco, Turnips): Apply up to 40 pounds per acre.
