GROUND SPRAY - FOR APPLES: (Using 100 gal. water) to prepare a 20 ppm spray. **FOR PEARS:** 500 gal. water. Crutch the trees with the support spray, which provides an equivalent of 25 gal 7 days before harvest. Do not make more than an "oil-type" spray, add 1 pint of favorable **AIRPLANE SPRAY - APPLES AND PEARS:** of favorable summer oil by thorough agitation. **FOR PEARS:** use 11 fl. oz. of this product in 5

DIRECTIONS FOR

Fruit Fix CONCENTRATE 200 is also of heavy fruit set is expected.

TIMING IS CRITICAL: Spray when young 2 1/2 weeks following full bloom. Thinning is **WITHOUT OIL** - Apply a solution of 150 pp 38 fl. oz. and a wetting agent (e.g. "Dial") 14 **WITH OIL** - Apply a solution of 100 ppm thoroughly 24 fl. oz. with 100 gallons of water summer oil. Spray only the heavily loaded tree 30 gallons per tree.
