DIRECTIONS

Citrus and Avocados:

To control snails apply at the rate of 38 to 50 lbs. per acre. Broadcast between rows, to give even distribution, with ground equipment only. Application should be made when foliage and fruit is completely dry but soil is wet following irrigation. Late afternoon or early evening applications are preferred. **Do not apply within 14 days of harvest. Do not make more than two applications per season. Do not allow granules to contaminate edible portions of plant.**

Lawn and Turf areas, Flower Gardens, Ornamental Ground Covers, Greenhouses, and Commercial Ornamental Nurseries: For best snail control results, thoroughly water area to be treated 12 to 24 hours prior to application. Sprinkle 1 percent granules uniformly over 1,000 square feet of area. Do not pile granules in piles. Scatter granules uniformly over the ground. When making applications special attention should be given to treating areas around plant beds, under greenhouse benches, on edges of lawns and areas behind foundations. On small or narrow beds, apply material in bed penetrators. Evening application gives most effective control. The effective life of the granules can be increased if watering is avoided for as long as possible after application. Repeat applications as necessary to keep areas free of snails. **Do not use on plants grown for food.**
