Dear Mr. Brock:

The Agency has complete the technical review of the Dermal Sensitization Study (MRID 452364-01) that was submitted with this amendment. This study is acceptable. Based on the data submitted with this study, this product is classified as a skin sensitizer. A copy of the Agency's memorandum report dated October 20, 2003 is enclosed for your records.

The amended label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act as amended is acceptable provided the following changes are made:

1. **FIRST AID:** The routes of exposure must be listed in order of decreasing acute toxicity category. List the routes of exposure in the following order:

If on skin or clothing
If in eyes
If inhaled
If swallowed

## 2. HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS:

- Add the following sentence that is required for products that are skin sensitizers:
   "Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals."
- In the third line, change "handlin" to "handling".

3. **ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:** Change this text to agree with that specified in the Label Review Manual, 3<sup>rd</sup> edition, page 8-8:

"This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA."

One copy of the label stamped "Accepted with comments" is enclosed for your records. This label supercedes all labels previously accepted for this product. Please submit one copy of the final printed label that incorporates the required changes before the product is released for shipment.
