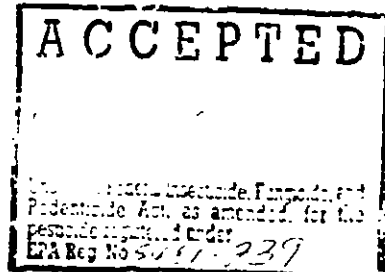


**RESTRICTED USE PESTICIDE

For Retail Sale to and Use only by Certified Applicators or Persons under their direct supervision, and only for those uses covered by the Certified Applicator's certification. This product is a Restricted Use Herbicide due to ground water concerns. Users must read and follow all Precautionary Statements and Instructions for use in order to minimize potential for Atrazine to reach ground water.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person. **IF INHALED:** Remove victim to fresh air. PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid inhalation of dust. Do not get in eyes. Avoid contamination of food and feed. Wash thoroughly after handling and before eating or smoking.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Simazine and Atrazine are chemicals which can travel (seep or leach) through soil and can contaminate ground water which may be used as drinking water. These chemicals have been found in ground water. Users are advised not to apply this product where the water table (ground water) is close to the surface and where the soils are very permeable, i.e. well-drained soils such as loamy sands. Your local agricultural agencies can provide further information on the type of soil in your area and the location of groundwater. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands. See **WORKER SAFETY & USER PRECAUTIONS** paragraph on side panel.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. **STORAGE:** Store product in its original labeled container in a cool dry locked place out of reach of children. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned stay out of smoke.

IMPORTANT - WORKER SAFETY AND USER PRECAUTIONS

Users are required to wear long sleeved shirts and long pants or equivalent, chemical resistant gloves, and boots (waterproofed). In addition, persons involved in mixing/loading operations are required to use chemical resistant rubber or neoprene gloves and a face shield or goggles. Ground water contamination may be reduced by diking and flooring of permanent liquid bulk storage sites with an impermeable material. This product may not be mixed/loaded, or used within 50 feet of all wells, including abandoned wells, drainage wells, and sink holes.

FOR GRASSY AND BROADLEAF WEED CONTROL ON INDUSTRIAL SITES, FIREBREAKS, AND RIGHTS-OF-WAY WHEN TO APPLY

PRINTREX 2-5G Granular Herbicide should be applied before or shortly after weeds emerge. For best weed control, schedule the application just prior to expected rainfall. Since the active ingredients in PRINTREX 2-5G enter the weeds mainly through their roots, rainfall or irrigation are needed to move the herbicides into the root zone. Very dry soil conditions following application may necessitate follow-up use of a contact herbicide or shallow cultivation. PRINTREX 2-5G is non-corrosive to equipment, non-flammable and has a low electrical conductivity.

WEEDS CONTROLLED

A wide variety of annual and perennial weeds will be controlled such as Barnyard Grass, Bluegrass, Burdock, Canada Thistle, Cheatgrass, Crabgrass, Dog Fennel, Foxtails, Lambsquarter, Orchardgrass, Plantain, Puncture Vine, Purple Top, Quackgrass, Ragweed, Redtopgrass, Smooth Brome, and Turkey Mullein.

WHERE AND HOW MUCH TO APPLY

Apply evenly with manual or power granule spreading equipment to non-crop areas such as Utility, Highway, Pipeline, and Railroad Rights-of-way, Petroleum-Tank Farms, Lumber yards, Storage Areas, Industrial Sites, Firebreaks and around Buildings at rates of from 100 to 200 lbs. per acre. Where areas to be treated have perennial growth or where soil is heavy-textured, the higher rate should be used. In light soils or where growth of perennials is generally absent, the lower rate (100 lbs./acre) should be used and if required, may be used at that rate up to twice in any one calendar year. Extensive deep rooted growth areas may require another treatment the following year at the 200 lb/acre rate. For small areas use 4.6 lbs. per 1,000 Sq. Ft. which is equivalent to 200 lbs. per acre.

The maximum established rate for use on non-crop land for industrial weed control must not exceed a maximum of 200 lbs. of PRINTREX 2-5G per acre, per calendar year.
