STATEMENTS OF PRACTICAL TREATMENTS

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. DO NOT INDUCE vomiting unless other treatment is not available. If there are signs of parasympathetic stimulation Atropine Sulfate should be injected at 10 minute intervals in doses of 1 to 2 milligrams until complete atropinization has occurred. Morphine is contraindicated. 2 PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with Atropine. Clear chest by postural drainage. Repeated exposure to cholinesterase inhibitors may without warning cause prolonged susceptibility to very small doses of any cholinesterase inhibitor. Allow no further exposure until time for cholinesterase regeneration has been allowed as determined by a blood test.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to water. Do not apply where run-off is likely to occur. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from areas treated. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

One gallon of spray should treat a small three bedroom home, as directed indoors and outdoors.

IMPORTANT NOTICE - READ BEFORE APPLYING THIS FOR HOUSEHOLD INSECT CONTROL:

The solvent or Active Ingredients in this product may stain certain fabric, plastic, rubber and asphalt materials such as tiles, carpet, and floor coverings. Avoid treating them or treat a very small inconspicuous area first to see if the material is affected by the spray. If unaffected treat them sparingly and clean thoroughly after the insecticide has dried. Otherwise do not treat.

WHERE TO USE

For Application Within Residential Buildings Including Homes and Apartments Buildings, and within Nonfood Areas of Industrial, Institutional and Commercial Buildings including. Hospitals, Stores, Manufacturing Plants and arehouses: Do not use in edible products area of food processing plants, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. For rapid knockdown and residual control of Fleas, and Brown Dog Ticks apply as a light coarse spray mist "Spot Treatment" to localized areas of floors and floor coverings, near cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames, to pet sleeping quarters area and pet bedding. Replace with fresh bedding in pet sleeping quarters following treatment. To control the source of Flea infestations, plan on treating pets with a suitable EPA approved Flea Control Product that may be used directly on the animal. NOTE: Do not apply to birds or animals. Do not apply in milk houses. Remove animals from premises while spraying.

OUTDOOR USEPREMISE TREATMENT

This product is Ready To Use for control of Ants, Clover Mites, Grackles, Earwigs, Fleas, Flies, Millipedes, Mosquitoes, Sowbugs, and Brown Dog Ticks.

Spray outside premises and building foundation infested areas thoroughly, including outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames, foundations, patios, and other places where insects may enter. For Ants, spray hills, and ant trails and repeat as necessary. DO NOT SPRAY FLOWERS, VEGETABLES, ORNAMENTALS, OR OTHER VEGETATION. Use only as a premise or foundation spray.
