DIRECTIONS: For transplanting in general mix a solution of one teaspoonful of ALCO Vitamin B-1 Hormone Concentrate in one gallon of water. Thoroughly saturate the soil around the plant with the solution.

For use on Cuttings, Potted Plants, Trees, Shrubs, Flowers or House Plants, ALCO Vitamin B-1 Hormone Concentrate should be used at the same dilution rate (1 tsp. per gallon water) applied at weekly intervals until the plants become established.
