<u>POTATO SEED-PIECE TREATMENT:</u> For Damping Off Seed Rot apply at the rate of 2 lbs. per 130 lbs. of seed pieces. Coat each potato seed piece evenly with a light film of dust. Treated pieces should be stored for 2 days in open crates if planting is delayed by 2 or more days. Treat pieces within 6 hours after cutting.

STRAXBERRIES: For Botrytis Fruit Rots apply 40 to 50 lbs. per acre. beginning as soon as new growth starts and repeat at weekly intervals. Shorten the interval under conditions of frequent rains, heavy dews; or other conditions favorable to infection.
