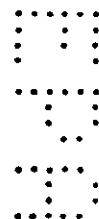

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT (Cont.)
CALL A PHYSICIAN IN ALL CASES OF SUSPECTED POISONING.**

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN - - - POISONING SYMPTOMS

Symptoms include weakness, headache, tightness in chest, blurred vision, non-reactive pin point pupils, salivation, sweating, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, and abdominal cramps. TREATMENT - Atropine is the specific therapeutic antagonist of choice against parasympathetic nervous stimulation. If there are signs of parasympathetic stimulation Atropine Sulfate should be injected at 10 minute intervals in doses of 1 to 2 milligrams until complete atropinization has occurred. Morphine is contraindicated. 2 PAM is also anti-dotal and may be administered in conjunction with Atropine. Clear chest by postural drainage. Repeated exposure to cholinesterase inhibitors may without warning cause prolonged susceptibility to very small doses of any cholinesterase inhibitor. Allow no further exposure until time for cholinesterase regeneration has been allowed as determined by a blood test.

DANGER: Poisonous if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin or eyes. Do not get on skin or in eyes. Do not breathe fumes. Rapidly absorbed through skin. Wear natural rubber gloves, water-proof protective clothing and goggles when handling.
