Add Label Statement Identifying the  
Inert Ingredient Di-(2-ethylhexyl)adipate  
ALCO Insect Strip  
EPA Registration Number 5481-338  
Your Submission Dated August 17, 1990

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Reinstate the following sentence under "Animal Buildings":

Do not contaminate milk or milking equipment.

2. Add "HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS" after "PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS."

3. Add an asterisk to "Inert Ingredients" and "This product contains the toxic inert ingredient Di-(2-ethylhexyl)adipate."

Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

# ALCO INSECT STRIP

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

When ready to use, unwrap original package and follow ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS. Homes, Motels, Cabins, Garages: To control flies, mosquitoes, gnats, use one Insect Strip per average size room (10 x 10 x 10 feet). Normally this is effective for four months. Replace strip if effectiveness diminishes.

**Garbage Cans and Trash Dumpsters:** For control of flies in garbage cans and dumpsters attach Insect Strip inside can or dumpster. Keep lid on can and dumpster closed.

**Animal Buildings:** To control flies, mosquitoes, and gnats in Horse Barns, Calf Parlors, Hog Parlors, Stables, Poultry Houses, Tack Rooms and Dog Kennels, place one Insect Strip per 1,000 cu. ft. of space. If more than one strip is required, distribute them equally over area to be treated. Drafts, weather and other conditions may effect the performance, but these usually last four months. Replace when effectiveness diminishes. Do not contaminate food, water or foodstuffs.

**Milk Rooms:** To control flies, mosquitoes, and gnats in milkrooms and bulk milk storage rooms hang one Insect Strip per 1,000 cu. ft. of space. Do not contaminate milk or milking equipment.

**Catch Basin:** To control Mosquitoes breeding in catch basins, suspend one Insect Strip about 10 inches above water line. Usual control is 10 to 15 weeks. Replace strip when effectiveness diminishes.

**Agricultural Commodities:** Bulk Storage of raw grains, corn, soybeans, cocoa beans, and peanuts. For control of Almond Moths, Cocoa Moth, Indian Meal Moth, and Mediterranean Flour Moths infesting non-perishable bulk stored raw agricultural commodities, suspend one Insect Strip per 1,000 sq. ft. of air space above the commodities before moths begin to emerge in early spring. Weather and drafts and other conditions effect the performance of the control, but this treatment usually lasts for four months. Replace strip when needed to prevent egg laying by moths.

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

**CAUTION:** Do not get in mouth, harmful if swallowed. After prolonged storage, a small amount of liquid may form on strip. Do not get liquid in eyes. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after handling strip. Do not use in hospitals or clinic rooms, such as patient rooms, wards, nurseries, operating or emergency areas. Do not use in any rooms where infants, the sick or aged are or will be present for any extended period of confinement. Do not use in kitchens, restaurants, or areas where food is prepared or served. Not to be taken internally by humans or animals. Do not use in edible product areas of food processing plants.

### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

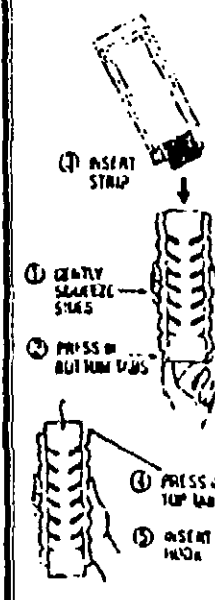
**If On Skin:** Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected area with soap and water.

**If In Eyes:** Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Do not open or remove from package before ready to install. Store in cool, dry place. Do not reuse packaging. Wrap used packaging in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash collection.

- ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS**
1. Gently squeeze edges of holder to open ends of unit.
  2. Press in bottom locking tabs to prevent strip from sliding out of holder.
  3. Without damaging the strip inside, carefully cut open envelope with scissors. Slide INSECT STRIP into the holder at the top.
  4. Press in top locking tabs to secure strip inside holder.
  5. To hang, attach metal hook through hole of unit.
