Subject: Label Amendment in Response to Basic Supplier's Deletion of Certain DDVP Uses
Alco Bug Spray Pressurized
EPA Registration No. 5481-340
Your Submission Dated December 17, 1996

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling:

1. Under "Directions for Use" add the statement: "For crack and crevice use only in homes, cabins, garages, basements, animal buildings, dairy milk rooms, warehouses, and industrial plants."
2. Under Directions for Use add: "For residential crack and crevice use, do not apply DDVP containing products more frequently than once per month."
3. Throughout the labeling qualify "food" with "feed." For example: "food/feed processing plants"; "nonfood/feed processing areas"; etc."
4. Under Directions add "Not for Use in Federally Inspected Meat and Poultry Plants."
5. Under Directions change "edible product areas" to "food/feed handling areas."
6. The "Nonfood areas" statement should follow the sentence beginning "Do not use in edible product....."

Submit two copies of each final printed labeling before you release the products for shipment. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

STATEMENTS OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash areas with soap and water.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present atropine sulfate is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with skin or eyes. Avoid breathing of spray mist. Wash thoroughly after handling and before smoking or eating. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Not for Use in USDA Meat and Poultry Plants.

Do not use as a Space Spray.

Do not use in hospitals or clinical rooms, such as patient rooms, wards, nurseries, operating or emergency areas. Do not use in any rooms where infants, or the sick or aged are, or will be present for any extended period of confinement. Do not use in food handling areas of restaurants, or areas where food is prepared or served. Do not use in edible product areas of food processing plants. Do not use to treat non-perishable bagged and / or bulk stored raw or processed agricultural commodities. Avoid contamination of utensils, food, water and foodstuffs. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed. Non-food areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets, and storage (after canning or bottling). Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate the areas after treatment is completed.

Follow instructions for specific pests as listed below, repeating treatments as necessary.

FLEAS, TICKS

Thoroughly spray localized infested areas including floors, baseboards, door and window frames and sleeping quarters of pets. Repeat as necessary. Place fresh bedding in animal quarters after treatment. Do not spray pets.

ROACHES, WATERBUGS, SILVERFISH, ANTS, SPIDERS, CENTIPEDES, MILLIPEDES, SOW BUGS.

Spray liberally into breeding and hiding places such as cracks, around baseboards, cabinets, walls and woodwork. Thoroughly treat trails, runs, and other places where pests crawl, or are seen. Spray directly on insects when possible. Repeat as necessary.

CARPET BEETLES, CLOTHES MOTH LARVAE

Clean and air contaminated materials before treating. Spray directly on pests, repeating treatment as needed. Treat upper and under sides of carpets for carpet beetles. Articles not stored in moth tight containers should be retreated at 30 day intervals. Allow all articles to thoroughly dry before use.

BEDBUGS

Spray cracks and surfaces in baseboards, floors, molding, and other contaminated areas. Take bed apart and treat mattress, springs, frame, and bedding. Air mattress for at least 4 hours before re-use.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in a cool area away from children. Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
