Animal Buildings

Controls flies, mosquitoes and gnats in horse barns, calf parlors, hog parlors, stables, poultry houses, tack rooms and dog kennels. Do not contaminate food, water or foodstuffs. DO NOT contaminate milk or milking equipment.

Milk Rooms

Usual control lasts 10 to 15 weeks.

Enclosed Utility Boxes

To control Fire Ants, Wasps and other insects as listed which commonly infest utility enclosures, cabinets conduits, junctions boxes, enclosed electrical panels and motor control rooms. Remove from sealed bag and hang or stand so air can contact all sides of the strip. Use a size appropriate for the space being treated: one (1) 5.25 g strip per 25 to 50 cu. ft. or one (1) 10.5 g strip per 50 to 100 cu. ft. or one (1) 16 g strip to treat 100 to 200 cu. ft. of enclosed space for utility equipment such as communications equipment, electric, gas, water and cable television. Record installation date and replace when effectiveness diminishes.

Enclosed Deer Stands and Duck Blinds

One 10.5 g strip will treat 50 to 100 cu. ft. One 16 g strip will treat 100-200 cu. ft. Record the date of installation and replace with a new, fresh, full strength strip at the end of four (4) months or when effectiveness diminishes. Do not use in food/feed processing or food/feed manufacturing or food/feed service establishments. Non-food/feed areas of these establishments where the product can be used are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets, and product storage (after canning or bottling).
