The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Add a Statement of Practical Treatment as follows:

IF IN SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and  
wash affected area with soap and  
water.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water.  
Call a physician if irritation  
persists.

2. Revise the Storage and Disposal section as follows:

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by  
storage or disposal. Store product in...

3. Add an asterisk to "Inert Ingredients" and "This product contains the toxic inert ingredient Di-(2-ethylhexyl)adipate."

4. Delete the statement "Practically Odorless" since this statement is misleading and insupportable.

To control Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, and other Small Flying Insects, place one Insect Strip per average room (10 x 12 ft. area). Normally, this is effective for 4 months. If more than one room is to be treated, place strips equally over area to be treated. Weather and other conditions may affect the performance. Replace strips if effectiveness diminishes. For use in garbage cans, attach one Insect Strip inside an average size garbage can. It will be effective for the entire fly season (keep lid on garbage can).
