The supplemental label for early-season use in cotton referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is accepted, subject to the comments made below. This label is supplemental to the label which the Agency accepted for this product on March 12, 2007, as modified by our letter of that date.

This supplemental label expires on January 21, 2011. Early-season use on cotton may continue if it is incorporated onto the full label for this product by that time or at the next printing of the full label, whichever comes first.

Revise the supplemental label as indicated below.

1. The "**RESTRICTED USE PESTICIDE**" box must be moved to the very top of the label, above the product name and "**AMVAC AGRICULTURAL BULLETIN**". The heading "**RESTRICTED USE PESTICIDE**" must appear in 18-point type or larger.
2. Change the second paragraph under "**Directions for Use**" to read:

**THIS LABEL AND THE FULL FEDERALLY REGISTERED LABEL FOR THIS PRODUCT MUST BE IN THE POSSESSION OF THE USER AT THE TIME OF APPLICATION.**

3. Directly below the heading "**SUPPLEMENTAL USE DIRECTIONS**", insert the following sentence:


