Dear Mr. Wood:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments below. Two copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

- 1. Change "Inert Ingredients" to "Related Compounds" as on the previously accepted label. Certain of the impurities in the product's formulation may be considered "related compounds." Before we will approve use of "Inert Ingredients", you must submit data and/or a justification to show that the product's impurities are, in fact, inert ingredients.
- 2. Revise the last sentence of the third paragraph under "Limited Warranty and Disclaimer" to read "To the extent allowed by law, manufacturer or seller shall not be liable for any special, indirect or consequential damages resulting from the use or handling of this product." As currently written ("In no event, shall manufacturer or seller be liable ...") the statement negates and/or detracts from labeling requirements as set forth by the Agency in 40 CFR Part 156, and is, therefore, considered misbranding.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

<u>Poisoning Symptoms</u>: Symptoms include weakness, headache, tightness in chest, blurred vision, non-reactive pin point pupils, salivation, sweating, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, and abdominal cramps.

TREATMENT: Atropine is the specific therapeutic antagonist of choice against parasympathetic nervous stimulation. If there are signs of parasympathetic stimulation, Atropine Sulfate should be injected at 10 minute intervals in doses of 1 to 2 milligrams until complete atropinization has occurred. Pralidoxime chloride (2-PAM) may also be used as an effective antidote in addition to and while maintaining full atropinization.

In adults, an initial does of 1 gram of 2-PAM should be injected, preferably as an infusion in 250 cc of saline over a 15 to 30 minute period. If this is not practical, 2-PAM may be administered slowly by intravenous injections as a 5 percent solution in water over not less than 2 minutes. After about an hour, a second dose of 1 gram of 2-PAM will be indicated if muscle weakness has not been relieved. For infants and children the dose of 2-PAM is 0.25 grams. Morphine is an improper treatment. Clear chest by postural drainage. Oxygen administration may be necessary. Observe patient continuously for 48 hours. Repeated exposure to cholinesterase inhibitors may without warning cause prolonged susceptibility to very small doses of any cholinesterase inhibitor. Allow no further exposure until cholinesterase regeneration has been attained as determined by blood test.
