The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the above referenced product in connection with the Sodium methylthiocarbamate RED, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable. The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.

NOTE: This product is **not** yet being reregistered under section 4(g) of FIFRA.



PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

Caution: Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Harmful if inhaled. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Avoid breathing vapor. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse.

Appropriate PPE (long pants, long-sleeved shirts and chemical-resistant gloves) must be used when applying this product.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to mammals, birds, aquatic invertebrates and fish. Do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to inter-tidal areas below the high water mark. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters or rinsate. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance, contact your State Water Board or EPA Regional Office.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. For any pesticide requirements specific to your State or Tribe, consult the agency responsible for pesticide regulation. Federal, State, or local regulations may require permits for the use or disposal of the treated materials.

Sewage Sludge [Biosolids] and Animal Waste Treatment

RID-A-VEC is effective in reducing the number of viable sludge pathogens (excluding pests of significant public health importance as defined in PRN 2002-1) in sewage sludge [biosolids] and animal waste. The effectiveness has been shown for helminth ova and bacteria (e.g., fecal coliform and Salmonella species). RID-A-VEC is also effective in the reduction or elimination of odors in sewage sludge [biosolids] or animal waste. RID-A-VEC is applied as a concentrated liquid, and can be used in either an indoor or outdoor processing system.

A closed system is used when applying this product. During the sludge treatment process, RID-A-VEC is metered through an injection system into the processing vessel at the rate of 1 to 3 gallons of RID-A-VEC per ton of sewage sludge [biosolids] or animal waste. The combination is mixed completely to ensure good contact of RID-A-VEC with the sewage sludge [biosolids] or animal waste. Treated material must be placed in a protected storage area for 21 days. Rinsate should be collected, and reintroduced into the treatment process. In the case of sewage sludge [biosolids], treated sewage sludge [biosolids] can only be land-applied in accordance with local, state, and federal

requirements. Sites to which treated materials have been applied, or in which they are being used, should be tested for phytotoxicity prior to planting, or transplanting, plants to such sites.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Do not expose to extreme temperatures. Do not stack more than four drums high. Leaking or damaged drums should be placed in overpack drums for disposal. Spills should be absorbed in sawdust or sand and disposed of in a sanitary landfill. Keep container closed when not in use.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a tank mix. Repeat this procedure two more times.
