Delete the site Dog and Cat Flea collars from indoor use sites. The risk from this use was not assessed in the RED, therefore this use is not eligible for reregistration.

If signs of cholinesterase inhibition appear, atropine sulfate is antidotal. 2-PAM (Protopam) is also antidotal and may be used in conjunction with atropine, but should not be used alone. Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.
