 - Through-out the label revise all "imported fire ants and fire ants" statements by add an asterisk, "imported fire ants*" and "fire ants*" with a legible footnote reading "aids in control".
 - c) On the front panel delete the user statement beginning, "For Use by individuals/firms licensed or registered ... etc". This statement is in conflict with the Restricted Use Statement.
 - d) On the front panel delete "sod farms". Sod farms is subject to the Workers Protection Standard (WPS) and the labeling must bear the appropriate directions and precautions required in CFR 40 section 170 Work Protection Standard.

- e) Under Directions for Use add, the WPS disclaimer statement,
 - "Not for use on plants being grown for sale or other commercial seed production or for research purposes. Not for use on sod farms, nurseries, commercial greenhouses."
- f) Under Storage and Disposal delete the instructions for "Homeowner Container Disposal". This product is a restricted use pesticide and not available to homeowners.
- g) Revise the container disposal statement so that it is consistent with the criteria for container disposal under PR Notice 2007-4.
- 3. Generate and submit the results of an one year storage stability and corrosion characteristics study to the Agency on completion. It is recommended that the observations be made at 0, 3, 6, 9, and 12 months intervals.
- 4. Within 60 days submit a copy of the enforcement analytical method to the EPA Analytical Laboratory at the following address:

Best results are obtained if the areas are thoroughly watered soon after application.

Lawn (or Turf) & Perimeter Applications:

Perimeter application: Apply to lawn (or turf) area in a uniform band 6 to 10 ft. wide around and adjacent to structures to help prevent entry of insects into homes or buildings. Use at the rate of 2.30 lb to 4.60 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft depending on pest to be treated.

Lawn (or turf) application: Broadcast this product with suitable application equipment which is properly calibrated to ensure uniform coverage over the treatment area. Best results are obtained when two applications at half rates are made perpendicular to each other. Apply 2.30 lb to 4.60 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft. to control the following pests:

Pest List and Use Rates:

- To control Annual bluegrass weevil adults (Hyperodes sp.), Armyworms, Billbug adults, Black turfgrass ataenuis adults, Cutworms, Mealybugs, sod webworms and European crane fly, use at the rate of 2.30 lbs/1000 sq. ft.
- To control Ants, Centipedes, Chiggers (Red bugs), Chinch bugs, Fire ants, Fleas, Imported fire ants, Leafhoppers, Millipedes, Mole crickets, Ticks, Pillbugs and Sowbugs,, use at the rate of 4.60 lbs/1000 sq. ft.

Note: To improve overall control of Imported fire ant colonies, combine broadcast treatments with appropriate products approved for fire ant mound applications.
