GRO-WE L CRAB-N-WELD is a dry granular material which when applied to your lawn with a spreader will kill CRABGRASS mand certain broadleaf weeds, such as PLANTAIN, DANDLLION, PURSLANL, YARROW, COMMON CHICKWEED and GROUND IVY. May be applied at any time weeds are prevalent, as long as cautions given below are followed. For Crabgrass two to three applications, 10 to 14 days apart, may be necessary for best control. For broadleaf weeds one or two applications may be sufficient. Tince crabgrass continues to germinate throughout the summer months, rejeated treatments may be necessary to kill new growth.

To elidinate the possibility of future crabgrass infestations, it is recommended that an application of CED-WELL PRE-VENT (), a pre-emergent crabgrass control to applied each year to prevent the germination of crabgrass seedlings.
