### GRO-WELL REN-O-VATE

Gro-Well Ren-O-Vate is for use in destroying all top growth, both grasses and weeds prior to reseeding for a new lawn, or when used with care, for killing weeds and grasses around shrubs, trees and similar areas where there is unwanted vegetation.

Good results will be obtained if applied during the growing season from Spring through Fall on a warm day. Mow lawn at 1" height and rake before chemical is applied. Use 10 ozs. of Ren-O-Vate in 5 gallons of water and apply to 1000 sq. ft. of lawn area (20 x 50'). A sprayer such as the Gro-Well Shrub & Tree Sprayer, which attaches to a hose may be used. If this type sprayer is used, add additional water to the chemical in the jar so that the jar is filled up to the five gallon mark. This will give you the required 5 gallons of diluted spray material to be applied to 1000 sq. ft. If turf is matted or certain hard to kill weeds are present, a second application may be required five days later. Area should be dead and ready for seed five days after treatment. Wash sprayer out well after using.

- 1 Do not remove stubble. Because seed must come in contact with the soil, better results will be obtained if heavily matted and bare spots are loosened with an iron rake.
- 2 Apply a complete fertilizer, such as Gro-Well Lawn Builder according to recommendations for a new lawn.
- 3 Water and thoroughly soak area prior to seeding.
- 4 Use a good grade of lawn seed, such as Gro-Well Premium or Merion Mix and apply.
- 5 A very light top dressing of sterilized soil or finely ground peat will improve germination of seed.
- 6 Water again lightly in order to wash seed down into soil.
- 7 Keep area moist with frequent light waterings until at least the first mowing or until new grass fills in. If hot and dry, this could require two light waterings daily.

For killing vegetation around trees, shrubs, driveways, patios and other areas use the same dilution rate, thoroughly wetting foliage of vegetation to be killed, being most careful not to get any spray material on foliage, stems,

or bark of desirable plants. A repeat treatment may be necessary in five days.

**NOTE:** Material may crystalize at cold temperatures. This does not harm product. Return to room temperature and shake well.

**CAUTION:** Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing or inhalation of spraymist. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after using and before eating or smoking. Keep away from children and beneficial animals. Keep them off treated areas. Do not store near food and feed products. Do not use on vegetable gardens. Do not walk from treated areas onto areas which are not to be treated. Do not apply or allow to drift in areas occupied by unprotected persons or animals.
