Dear Mr. Freindlich:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable with the following provisions:

- 1. Revise the percentage of prometon in the Ingredients statement to read "2.15%". Correspondingly, the percentage for inert ingredients should be revised to read "96.68%".
- 2. Revise the second sentence of the Pesticide Disposal statement on the master label to read "Improper disposal of excess pesticides, spray mixture or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law may be contaminate groundwater."
- 3. Add the statement "avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing" to the Precautionary statements on the consumer (1 gallon) label.




