**GRO-WELL LAWN WEED BOMB** may be used for small area spot killing of many weeds such as Dandelion, Plantain, Common and Mouse Ear Chickweed, Ground Ivy, Mandib, Purslane, Spotted Spurge, Knotweed, Pennywort, Crane, Wild Onion, Parsnip Ivy and Oak and certain others without causing injury to desirable grasses when used as directed. An application of **GRO-WELL LAWN WEED BOMB** can easily be seen because of its white coloring and its consistency is such that dangerous drift to nearby desirable plants is cut to a minimum. One application will kill most of the weeds listed however, if it is apparent after 2 or 3 weeks that weeds are not dying a second application may be necessary.

**DIRECTIONS:** Remove protective cap. Shake bomb several times and hold about 1 foot from weeds to be killed. Be sure that arrow on valve is pointing away from you and toward the weeds to be killed. Depress valve for a short quick spray, thoroughly covering weed but not over dosing it. **NOTE:** Spray only on a calm day when there is no wind and when temperatures are below 85 to reduce the amount of vapors and drift which will injure susceptible desirable plants such as flowers or shrubs, which may be growing nearby. Do not apply to new lawns until after the 2nd or 3rd mowing and grasses have become established. Application should be made when rainfall is not expected for 24 hours. Do not mow area for 2 or 3 days after application. An excessive amount of spray may injure or temporarily brown desirable grasses. Use with care on Clover, St. Augustine and Dichondra lawns, as damage may result.

**POISON IVY-BAR:** Spray after leaves are fully grown, when air is calm (to avoid hitting desirable plants which would be damaged). Spray leaves around base and up several feet. Do not spray if leaves are entwined in desirable plants but cut plant at base and remove. Dead leaves can cause skin irritation, handle with gloves. Do not burn dead leaves or vines as smoke can cause severe injury to skin and lungs.

**CAUTION:** Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Keep out of reach of children. As with all chemicals, wash well after using and before smoking or eating. Avoid contamination of food, and feedstuffs. Do not store near other garden supplies such as seeds and fertilizers. Throw can away when empty. Avoid freezing as product may become impaired. Avoid contamination of water used for domestic purposes and irrigation ditches. Use with care on clover and bentgrass lawns as damage may result. Avoid drift of spray mist onto vegetables, flowers, ornamental trees, shrubs and other desirable crop plants. Vapors from this product may injure susceptible plants in the immediate vicinity.

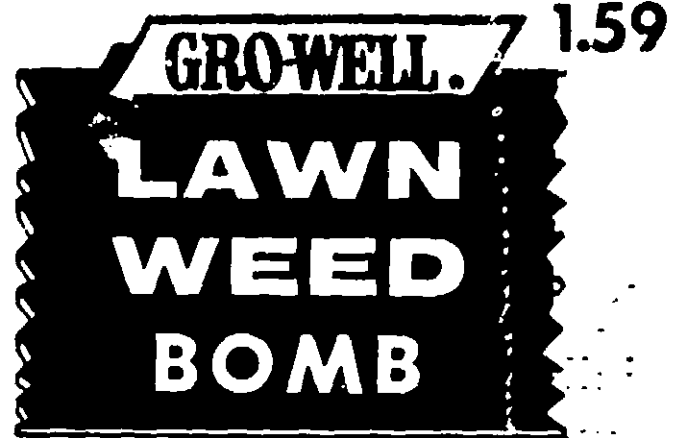

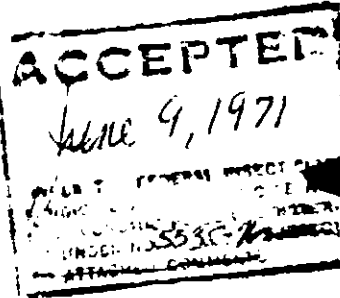
