GROWELL TOMATO & VEGETABLE BOMB may be used up to and including the day of ... to control certain insects on TOMATOES and certain VEGETABLES. Protect plants throughout the growing season by spraying early in the morning or in the evening when the air is still, before insects become numerous. Spray at 7 to 10 day intervals and after heavy rains. When spraying cover foliage thoroughly, paying particular attention to the under side of leaves, avoiding excessive over wetting as injury may occur. Spray with one (1) second bursts and where possible, spray so as to contact as many insects as possible.

TO OPERATE: Shake can well before using. Remove protective cap. Press button to release spray, keeping opening away from you. IMPORTANT HOLD CAN IN AN UPRIGHT POSITION AND AT LEAST 1 1/2 TO 2 FEET AWAY FROM PLANT WHILE SPRAYING.

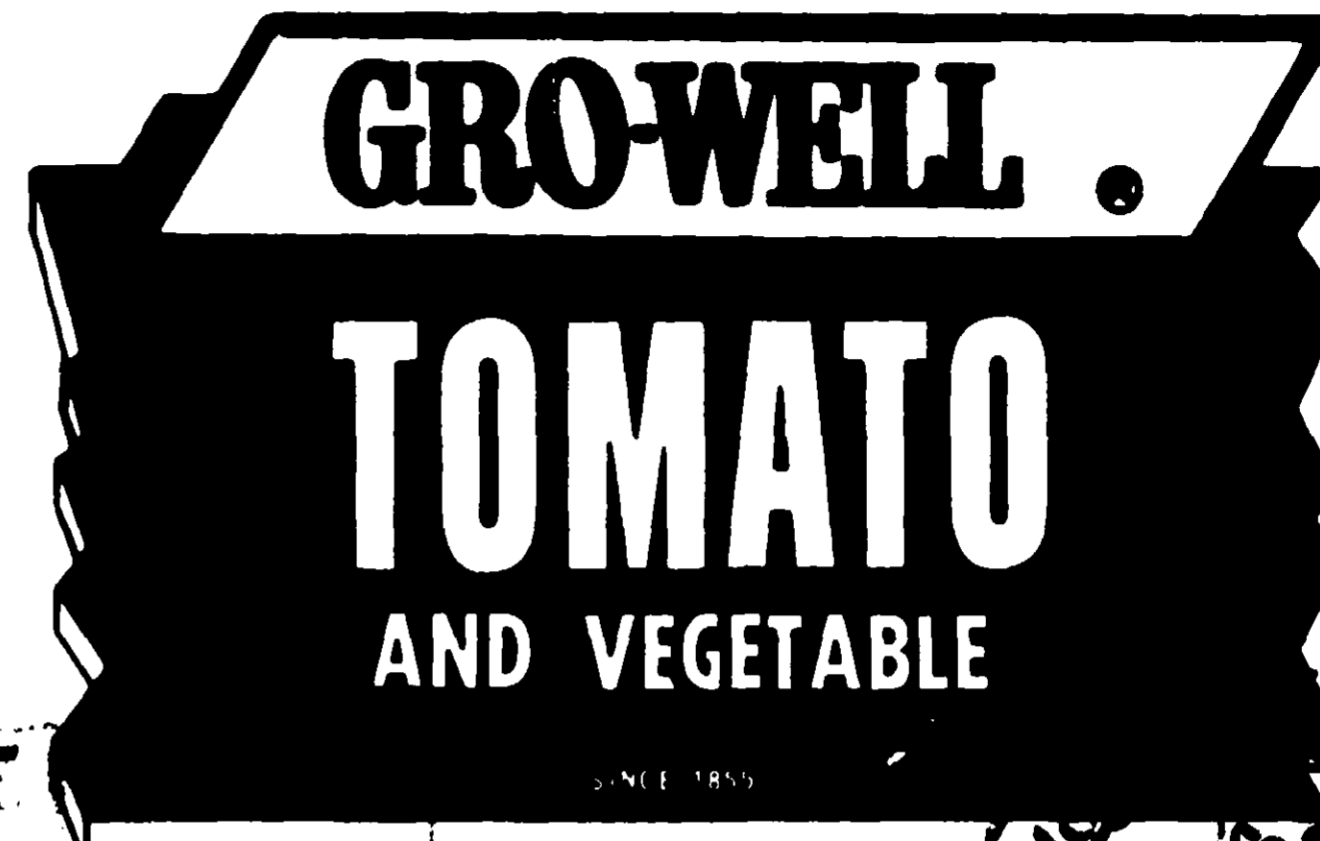
