DIRECTIONS

GRO-WELL® CHINCH BUG and LAWN INSECT KILLER will effectively control **CHINCH BUGS, SOD WEBWORMS (Lawn Moths), HYPERODES WEEVIL, EARWIGS and GRASSHOPPERS**, which infest lawns. To insure best possible results, mow lawn and remove clippings and excess thatch prior to application. After application is made, wash granules into soil with 10 gallons of water per 1,000 sq. ft. (20' x 50') of treated lawn area. Consult your Extension Service Specialist as to exact timing of application.

CHINCH BUGS — SOD WEBWORMS — EARWIGS — GRASSHOPPERS: Uniformly spread contents of bag to 5,000 sq. ft. (50' x 100') of lawn area, using spreader setting **A** given below. In Northeastern States, make first application in May or June, or when insects first appear. Retreat as needed, usually in July or August.

HYPERODES WEEVIL: Uniformly apply contents of bag to 2,500 sq. ft. (50' x 50') of lawn area, using spreader setting **B** given below. Make first application in mid-April and again in mid-May, or when insects first appear.

GRUB CONTROL: To control larvae of **JAPANESE BEETLE** and **EUROPEAN CHAFER** uniformly apply contents of this bag to an area of 2,500 sq. ft. (50' x 50') for light to medium grub infestation, using spreader setting **B** given below. For heavy infestations, uniformly apply contents of this bag to an area of 1,250 sq. ft. (25' x 50'), using spreader setting **C** given below. Immediately after application, water area following directions as outlined above. For best results, treat when grubs are young and actively feeding near the soil surface, usually during late July and August. Consult your local agricultural extension service specialist for proper timing of treatment in your particular area.

CAUTION: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN, HARMFUL IF SWALLOWED OR INHALED. Avoid breathing of dust. Keep children and pets off treated areas until material is washed into soil and grass is completely dried. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. For eye contact, flush profusely with water and get medical attention. Wash thoroughly after using and before smoking or eating. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Avoid contamination of feed, foodstuffs and domestic water supplies. If spilled, sweep up and dispose of in a safe manner.

Do not reuse container. Destroy when empty. Dispose of empty container and wastes by burying in non-crop lands away from domestic water supplies.

ENVIRONMENTAL CAUTIONS: This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Keep out of any body of water. Do not apply where run-off is likely to occur. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from areas treated. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment, or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Chlorpyrifos is cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine is an antidote.
