#### **Directions for Use**

Apply recommended amounts when air is calm, using ground equipment, aircraft or hand duster. Apply at first sign of infestation and repeat at weekly intervals when needed to maintain control. Good underleaf coverage is essential since the insect must ingest Thuri - 90 Garden Düst. After eating Thuri — 90 Garden Dust, some insects stop feeding but may otherwise appear to be unaffected for several days.

Use the lowest recommendation only with hand duster and against light infestation.
